With an estimated volume of 300 cubic miles of deep, cold water, the canyon exerts a vast weather influence on these regions, expressed through fog, wind and limited rainfall throughout the grape growing season.

Our premium Pinot Noir grapes were sourced from carefully selected blocks in our first-class estate vineyards located in Arroyo Seco, renowned for its distinctive climate and diverse soil composition. Bathed in the coastal sun by day and cooled by the refreshing ocean breeze at night, these vineyards create the optimal conditions for our grapes to ripen slowly, resulting in an unparalleled depth of concentrated fruit flavors and exceptional balance perfect for our premium reserve collection.

TASTING NOTES

Our Reserve Collection Pinot Noir is meticulously aged in French oak, resulting in a wine that exudes the elegance of our estategrown Arroyo Seco vineyards. Exhibiting notes of juicy raspberry and dry strawberry, the wine finishes smoothly on the palate with a silky texture and hints of allspice and vanilla.

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
