The Pacific Ocean profoundly impacts life in and around its waters. This is most evident with a geological marvel, the Blue Grand Canyon, that lies underneath Monterey Bay and links the sea to grape cultivation. Serving as a climatic pathway, this profound canyon connects the ocean to all four wine-growing regions that stretch southward down the Salinas Valley. With an estimated volume of 300 cubic miles of deep, cold water, the canyon exerts a vast weather influence on these regions, expressed through fog, wind and limited rainfall throughout the grape growing season.
